Adult Code of Conduct Form

While the Board of MMYSL and its affiliates recognizes the importance on winning matches or games in any sport, we also recognize that as a volunteer organization there are other inherent aspects of sports that are as important, if not more so than the outcome of any given match. Included in this philosophy are the following:

1. This is first and foremost an organization dedicated to the development and enjoyment of the game of soccer for the **children participating** in this league
2. Hard work, dedication, and team play help improve not only the skills of the individual player but also support the success of the team
3. The integrity and spirit of the game of soccer is such that win or lose, there are always valuable lessons that can be learned by playing a game as part of a team

And as such, we as adults should be able to embrace this philosophy and will abide by the following expectations:

- All adults involved at any level (parent, coach, manager or interested spectator) will respect the integrity and judgment of the officials and shall refrain from challenging referee calls in a dissenting or demeaning manner
- All adults will show appreciation for good play by both teams involved in a match
- All adults (other than the team's coach/coaches) will refrain from "coaching" any player from the touch lines of the field
- All adults will refrain from making dissenting comments of **ANY** nature to or about an opposing team player at **ANY** time during a match or within the vicinity of the field of play immediately after a match
- All adults will refrain from any unsporting behavior or comments to another adult from an opposing team during a match or within the vicinity of the field of play immediately after a match

Having read the aforementioned expectations, we agree to abide by these expectations. We also agree to accept any and all actions taken for failure to abide by these expectations.
